Butterbeer Cake

Cake Ingredients:

1 yellow cake mix prepared
3 oz instant vanilla pudding mix
1 teaspoon Root Beer extract
1 1/4/ teaspoon imitation caramel extract

Frosting Ingredients:

1 jar marshmallow fluff
1/2 cup butter
1 cup powdered sugar
1 teaspoon Root Beer extract
1 teaspoon imitation caramel extract

Cake Directions:

1. Preheat your oven to 350 degrees F.
2. In your mixer, prepare your cake mix according to the package, stirring in the vanilla pudding mix and the two extracts.
3. Place your batter in the pan of your choosing (cupcake, round cake, etc.)
4. Bake according to the cake mix package.

Frosting Directions:

1. In your mixer, beat together the marshmallow fluff and the butter until creamy.
2. Add in the powdered sugar and extracts. Beat until fluffy.
3. Frost your cake as desired.

Butterscotch Layer ingredients:

2 tablespoons butter
1 - 14 OZ. can sweetened condensed milk
3 cups butterscotch chips,

White-Chocolate Swirl Ingredients:

1/3 cup sweetened condensed milk
1/2 teaspoon pure vanilla extract
1 cup white chocolate chips
1 cup marshmallow bits (optional)

Directions:

1. Line an 8"x8" pan with aluminum foil and spray with cooking spray. Set aside.
2. Make the butterscotch layer: In a medium-sized saucepan over medium-low heat, melt butter, then add condensed milk and butterscotch chips. Stir until all chips have melted and the mixture has fully combined. Pour into the prepared pan.
3. Make the white chocolate swirl: In another small saucepan over medium-low heat, combine condensed milk, vanilla, and white chocolate chips and stir until chips have melted. Remove from heat and drizzle white chocolate on top of the butterscotch fudge, then use a butter knife to gently swirl the two flavors together. Top with marshmallow bits, if desired, using your hands to press them into the top of the fudge.
4. Refrigerate for at least 4 hours. Cut into slices and serve.
